### Tour Descriptions (see schedule for offerings):

- **Sunset With the Birds/Egans Creek Greenway**

Explore Egans Creek Greenway on a guided nature walk as the sun prepares to set. Learn to identify some of the native wildlife as they feed and prepare for the night. Tides will vary allowing the naturalist to focus on different communities and wildlife.

**Bring:** Binoculars and cameras, comfortable walking shoes, insect protection

**Meeting place:** 2500 Atlantic Ave. (Egans Creek Greenway trailhead behind the Atlantic Recreation Center)

- **Beach Tales/North Beach Park or Seaside Park**

Enjoy a guided nature walk along Amelia's beautiful ocean shore. Discover natural treasures along the way as we learn about the coastal ecosystem. Shelling, fossils, marine mammals, sea turtles and shorebirds are just a few of the topics that will be covered.

**Bring:** Bag for collecting beach treasure, sun protection, drinking water (if warm weather), shoes that may get wet

- **Greenway Discovery/EC Greenway**

Enjoy a guided nature walk along the trails of Egans Creek Greenway. Plants and animals of the Greenway will be highlighted. The tides will vary allowing the naturalist to focus on different communities and wildlife. Flowering vegetation and wildlife will vary depending on the season.

**Bring:** Binoculars and cameras, comfortable walking shoes, sun and insect protection

- **Nite Walk/Egans Creek Greenway**

Following a demonstration about night light, the tour will proceed to the north EC Greenway trail towards Citrona Dr., to the Beech St. bridge and back listening for animals (0.3 miles round trip). Everyone will wear a glow stick for safety purposes.
